



**Behaviour Expectations**  
***Promoting Positive Behaviour during COVID-19***  
**June 2020**

Before returning to school, all children are expected to have read and agreed to the behaviour expectations outlined below as well as the revised Home School Agreement. These are in line with government guidelines issued in May 2020.

**1. Arrangements for arrival and collection**

Children are expected to follow the revised arrangements for arrival and collection as outlined below.

- I will stand on the lines marked on the external pavement when waiting for school to open at my allocated time.
- I understand that arrival and collection times have been staggered to make sure that I do not mix with other children in the school at the same time.
- I will sanitise/wash my hands before entering the school building. A member of staff will be at the gate to explain where to do this.
- I will walk from/to the playground in a straight line and stand on the lines marked on the playground whilst maintaining physical distance between other children.

**2. Daily routines for hygiene, such as handwashing and sanitising**

- I will sanitise/wash my hands at the beginning of the day as well as before and after break and lunch.
- I will be expected to 'catch it, bin it, kill it' if I cough or sneeze. I will also be asked to wash my hands or use hand sanitiser immediately after.
- I will follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/hand sanitiser;
- I will avoid touching my face, especially my eyes, nose and mouth, with my hands.
- I will use the toilets responsibly and understand that an adult may need to accompany me to the toilet to ensure that only one child is using the toilet at any time.
- I understand that coughing deliberately at someone or spitting is completely unacceptable.

**3. Moving around the school**

- I will walk around the building sensibly, keeping my hands by my sides and not touching anything.
- I will keep an appropriate distance between myself and the person in front of me.
- I will only use the corridors and toilets designated to my class bubble.

#### **4. Expectations for breaks and lunchtime**

- I will sanitise/wash my hands at both the beginning and end of break and lunch.
- I understand that I will be allocated a time to use the playground during morning break and lunch time.
- I will ask permission to use the toilet during break/lunch time to ensure that there is only one child in the toilet at any time. I understand that an adult may need to accompany me to the toilet to ensure that only one child is using the toilet at any time.
- I understand that there will be limited playground equipment to use to minimise the chance of infection.
- I understand that games involving physical contact and sharing equipment will not be allowed.

#### **5. Sharing space, equipment or other items**

Teachers will explain changes to the physical environment and the reasons for these. Children in Years R-6 will be given equipment that only they will use: exercise book, pencil, sharpener, whiteboard, pen, rubber, colouring pencils etc. This will be kept at the child's table and not moved.

- I understand that the class furniture has been organised to maximise the space between the tables when children are sat down.
- I understand that I will only use the equipment provided to me by school and no other.
- I understand that there will be no sharing of equipment.
- I will not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school, other than my packed lunch (if needed) and water bottle.
